

## **AP Exams and OSU Course Credit**

Below you will find information on OSU credit that can be earned by Advanced Placement scores. The application of AP credit to degree requirements will vary by major, which you will discuss with your academic advisor when you attend your Orientation Program. The information below is intended to help you gauge the scores you would need to earn to receive course credit.

### **Advanced Placement (AP) Tests - Frequently Asked Questions**

The Advanced Placement Program (AP) Tests approved for EM credit are listed in this section. Tests are administered annually in May. To earn credit for AP scores, contact College Board at 1(888) 225-5427 to have your official score report sent to recipient code #1592, The Ohio State University Testing Center, 585 Student Academic Services Building, 281 West Lane Avenue, Columbus, Ohio 43210.

### **When are scores posted?**

OSU receives and posts scores electronically; generally scores are posted the same day they are received by OSU. Scores sent to OSU on exam day are generally received and processed by July 10th. Scores sent after exam day are generally received within a month from when they were sent.

### **My orientation program is before AP scores will be processed. How do I register for classes?**

All students will register for autumn semester courses during their orientation program. If you have not received your AP scores before your program, you will schedule your classes based on the current placement information you have (Math Assessment, English Placement, etc.) and, for certain subjects, an anticipated AP Score. Once you receive your scores, you will need to verify that you earned the score you anticipated. If you did not earn the score you anticipated while selecting your classes, contact your academic advisor immediately to appropriately adjust your schedule.

### **I sent scores to Ohio State, but my credits are not posted.**

First, verify on your AP Student Grade Report that The Ohio State University (1592) is listed as a score recipient. If not, contact the College Board at 1(888) 225-5427 to have scores sent to OSU. If OSU is listed as a recipient institution, verify the accuracy of your information. If these items are incomplete or inaccurate, we may need to update your record—call the Testing Center at (614) 292-2241.

If OSU is listed as a recipient institution and all demographic information appears correct, bring the original copy of your AP Student Grade Report to the Testing Center for processing.
